Regal enigmas, ancient Egyptian Scarabs, the labyrinth jewelry district of downtown Los Angeles, and the confidence of 1980s power dressing served up major inspiration for Rachel Loren's Pre-Fall '24. Referencing artifacts but infusing a modern minimalist ethos into her designs, Loren explores ouroboros shaped rings, elongated "vessel" briolette pendants and seductive Scarabs. The Chrysoprase stone seems to emerge from the handmade silver setting in the "Scarab" rings, pendants and hair pins. Playful opal pearl strands feature gems in an array of shades. Cleopatra huggies subtly allude to serpent silhouettes. Elevated 14kt gold safety pin ear rings are strung with pearls and opals. Emerald cut bezel pendants with oversized bales feel nostalgic and powerful at once. Channeling a grounded, calming aura the collection encourages a deep connection to the energy of the earth.

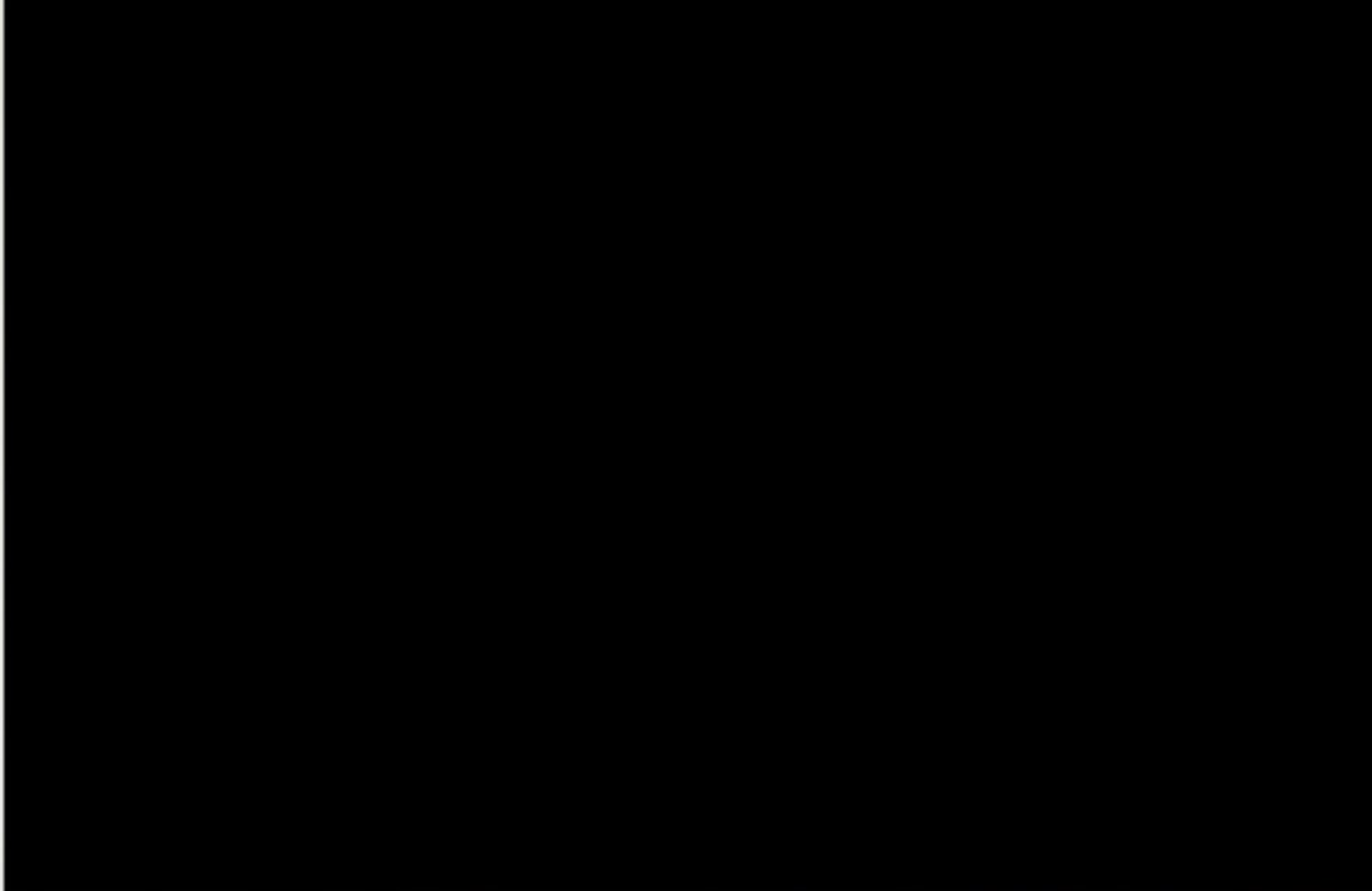

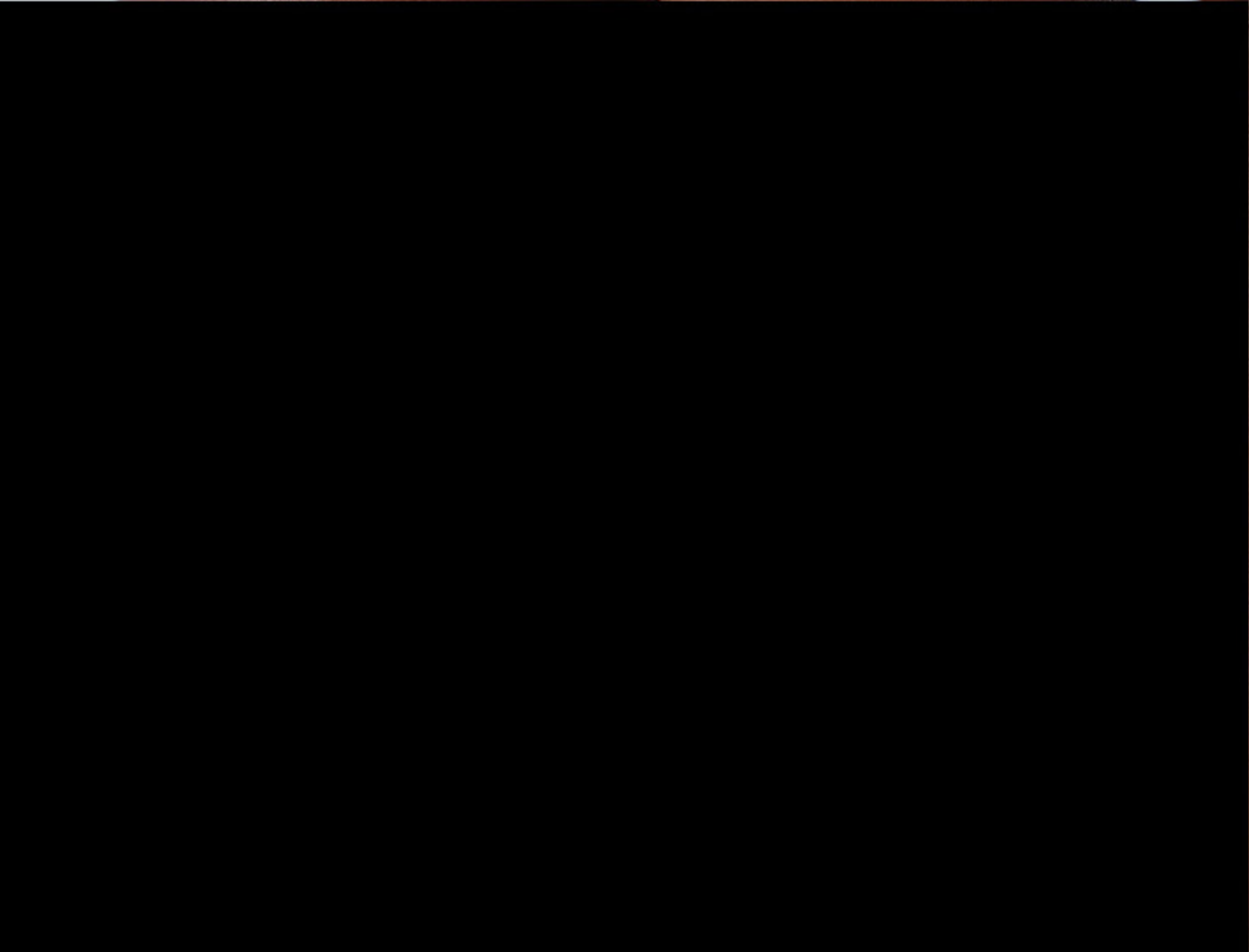
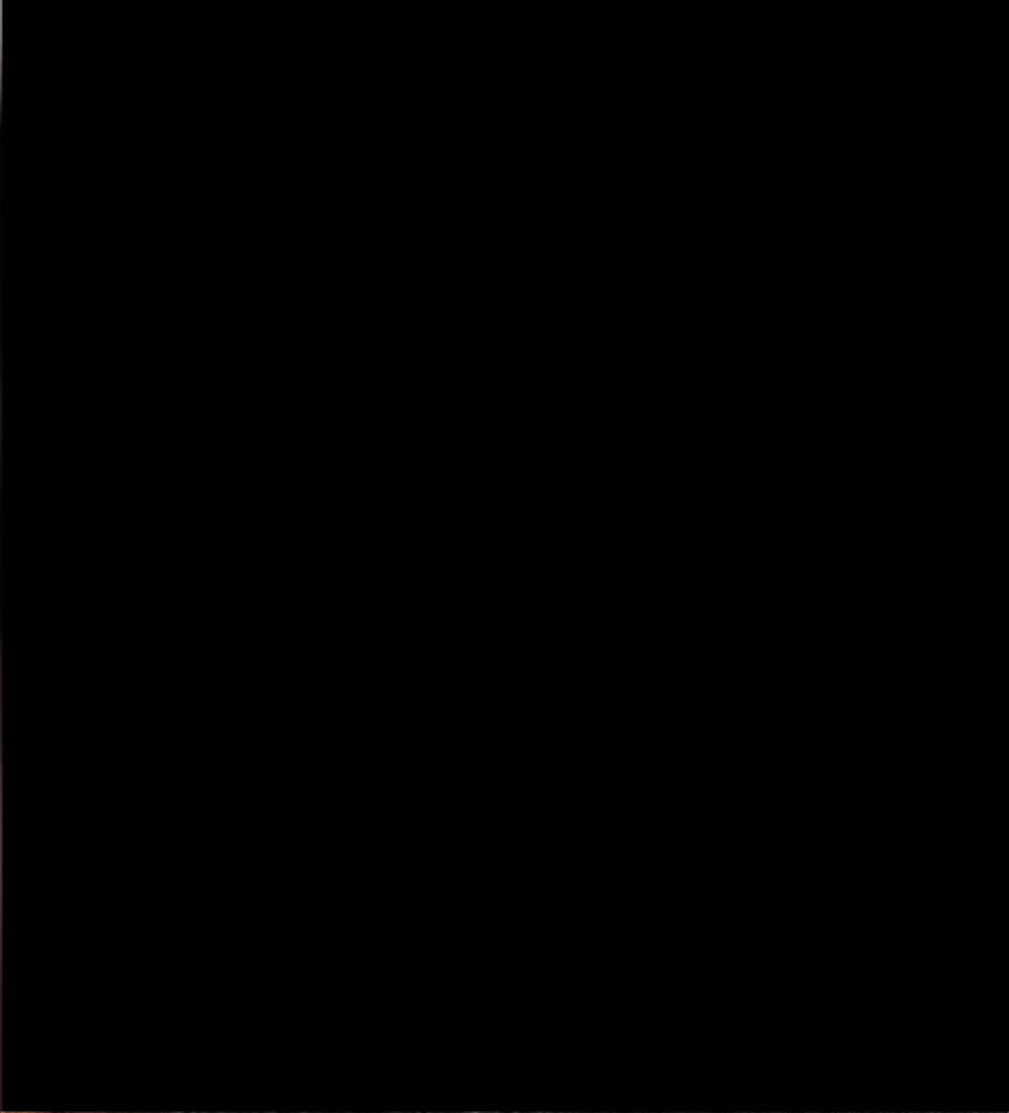
